Dear MIS Parents,

It's time to register for the 2010-2011 school year. Below you will find the tuition and fee breakdown for next year.

## 2010—2011 Tuition and Fees Information

<b>One Student Tuition</b>	\$6,990 per family/per year	\$4,710 per family/per year

<b>Four + Students Tuition</b>	\$17,390 per family/per year	\$12,030 per family/per year
<b>New Student Application Fee</b> Due upon acceptance of application	\$100/per student	\$100/per student

<b>Scrip Purchase Requirement</b> Each family is obligated to generate a <b>profit</b> for the school of \$150 in one of these two ways: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Purchase of scrip certificates before April 30, 2011 (note that each Scrip retailer generates a different percentage of profit)</li><li>• Cash buy-out of \$150 before September 1, 2010</li></ul>		
<b>Tuition Management</b> First month's tuition is due in July and the remaining tuition is paid in 9 monthly installments each month after. Each family will be required to enroll with Smart Tuition, a tuition management company, prior to the close of this school year. A fee of \$41 will be required at the time of enrollment. Details to come. Please note that tuition, registration and new student application fees are <u>non-refundable</u> .		

\* Mary Immaculate School is a ministry of Mary Immaculate Parish. Reduced tuition is offered to Catholic families who support Mary Immaculate Parish at a minimum of \$800 during a calendar year. To receive supportive family rates for the 2010-2011 school year, a family must have contributed a minimum of \$800 to Mary Immaculate Parish by 12/15/09. Families that did not complete the donation of \$800 by 12/15/09 will be assessed the non-supportive rate for tuition. Families new to Mary Immaculate School will be required to make the \$800 donation to the church to be eligible for supportive tuition status prior to their first tuition payment.
